Advanced technologies with M3

The M3 chip makes editing photos in Lightroom dramatically faster. And with Apple silicon, you get advanced Apple technologies like the Media Engine. So you can play and edit up to 12 streams of 4K ProRes video, or up to three streams of 8K, in apps like Final Cut Pro. And the Neural Engine accelerates machine learning tasks.

iMac has a 1080p FaceTime HD camera and studio-quality three-mic array, so you'll look and sound amazing when connecting with family and friends. And the six-speaker sound system with Spatial Audio support is great for calls, playing your favorite music, or watching movies with Dolby Atmos.

macOS Sonoma comes with a set of great preinstalled apps for productivity and creativity. It also introduces camera features like Studio Light, Reactions, Presenter Overlay, and Voice Isolation to make your video calls even more personal and engaging.

It's great for creative work

It has a resolution of 4480-by-2520—5 times the resolution of the most popular 24-inch all-in-one PC. It also has 500 nits of brightness, P3 color, and over a billion colors, so your images will look crisp and detailed on the 4.5K Retina display. And with M3, all your creative apps run faster and are more responsive—you can play back up to 12 streams of 4K, or up to three streams of 8K, simultaneously in your video projects.

Huge selection of compatible apps

Many apps come preinstalled with your iMac, and because you own an iPhone, most of them will feel familiar to you. You can also run apps that your workflows depend on—like Photoshop, Premiere Pro, After Effects, Audacity or Ableton Live. They all run natively on the M3 chip and take full advantage of Apple silicon technologies.

With hardware-accelerated ray tracing built into the GPU of M3, lighting and shadows become even more accurate. Game Mode automatically instructs the CPU and GPU to make your game the top priority. It also dramatically reduces latency with your favorite wireless accessories, like AirPods and PS5 or Xbox controllers.
