With Microsoft 365, customers can...

- Help your people connect, collaborate, and accomplish more together with Microsoft Teams
 - Stay focused by bringing meetings, chats, calls and collaboration together in one place
 - Connect to meetings with the most flexible set-up, integration and support for devices and accessories

Other productivity suites require additional 3rd party solutions to match built-in security = more risk. More limited compliance support and meet fewer compliance standards

- Minimize costs by reducing the need for 3rd party vendors and add-on apps
 - Make the most of existing investments with cloud, hybrid and on-premises deployment options
 - Get more advanced built-in features that can enable a lower TCO

Other productivity suites may mean management silos to navigate and secure due to 3rd-party apps. Limited iOS / Windows controls creates the need of 3rd party apps

- Help users do their best work with industry-leading apps and experiences
 - Collaborate in real-time with Microsoft Teams and familiar Office apps in the rich client or web
 - Advanced features with Power BI, Stream, and an employee experience platform
 - Nearly 300 million paid Office 365 commercial seats

Other productivity suites may mean additional third-party apps for features, adding cost and complexity. A cloud-only solution means limited range of deployment flexibility.

Other productivity suites lack a single hub for teamwork, cloud-only applications offer limited features and advanced features requiring additional 3rd party apps.
